## DISPATCH INFORMATION

R/O was dispatched to a priority call of a domestic in progress at 6534 Main St. in the Village of Eau Claire, the parking lot of the Chemical Bank.

## ARRIVAL ON SCENE

As R/O arrived on scene, R/O noticed that Officer Divis from the Berrien Springs Oronoko Township Police Department was already on scene and dealing with a male in the parking lot. R/O exited his vehicle and went to make contact with the female victim, who was sitting in the car at the ATM. As R/O went to make contact with the female, R/O noticed the male subject turn and start walking away from Officer Divis. Officer Divis gave the male subject multiple commands to come back and to stop. Officer Divis then told the male subject that he was not free to go and at that time the male subject took off running. R/O then gave chase with Officer Divis.

## CONTACT WITH DANIEL STEVEN WHITE

As R/O gave chase to suspect, DANIEL WHITE, across the parking lot and got close to WHITE, WHITE turned and took a defensive stand against R/O as if he was going to fight with R/O. At that time R/O delivered a front thrust kick to WHITE, who then buckled over at the waist and was taken to the ground. A fight ensued while on the ground with Officer Divis, R/O and WHITE. At that time, WHITE was told by R/O that he was under arrest, to stop resisting, and put his hands behind his back. WHITE refused and continued to fight with R/O. At that time R/O did a dry stun from the taser onto WHITE for approximately two seconds and that did not work. R/O and Officer Divis continued to fight with WHITE and a short while after that WHITE swung his fist at R/O and at that time R/O delivered a front punch to WHITE'S face, causing WHITE to turn over and then taken into custody.

## OFFICER INJURIES

R/O suffered lacerations on the left hand, both knees, and a possible fracture on the right hand.

## SUSPECT INJURIES

WHITE suffered a laceration to his left cheekbone area. WHITE was taken to Lakeland where he was cleared and lodged at the Berrien County Jail.

**OFFICER TREATMENT**

R/O was treated at the Lakeland Occupational doctor's office, where R/O was treated for the lacerations on the knees and hand and given x-rays on the right hand for a possible fracture to a bone in the hand.

**INTERVIEW - [REDACTED]**

R/O interviewed [REDACTED], who stated she had an altercation with DANIEL WHITE, who is the father of her two children and her boyfriend for the last seventeen years. [REDACTED] stated they have lived together for approximately the last sixteen years.

[REDACTED] stated on 5-2-2019 the Berrien County Sheriff's Department was at their residence earlier for an incident that took place earlier and they were separated and [REDACTED] went to stay the night with her mother.

[REDACTED] stated when she got up this morning, she has finals for her college courses and also has a job that she had to be to. [REDACTED] stated she went to her house at [REDACTED] St. in Eau Claire and went to retrieve some clothes and her books for school, so she could study for her finals. [REDACTED] stated when she went into the house, WHITE was there and he was still extremely intoxicated and it appeared he had been drinking all night. [REDACTED] stated immediately when she walked into the door, WHITE started an argument with her and started pushing her around the house and took her phone from her when she tried to call the police. WHITE refused to give [REDACTED] her phone back and stated she could have her phone back if she gave him some money.

[REDACTED] stated she then decided to take WHITE to the ATM and give him some money in an attempt to get WHITE out of there so she could get on with her day. [REDACTED] stated she figured the ATM had a camera on it and if anything happened, at least it would be recorded.

When they got to the Chemical Bank ATM in the Village of Eau Claire, she asked for her phone back and WHITE still refused. At that time she went to grab for her phone to get it back and WHITE grabbed her by the top of the her head by her hair, pulled her head down towards the center console in her vehicle and then started punching her on top of her head. [REDACTED] stated she then wrestled her phone out of WHITE'S hand and called 911.

**VICTIM MEDICAL TREATMENT**

[REDACTED] was seen by Medic One Ambulance and refused any treatment.

**VICTIM INJURIES**

[REDACTED] had some scratches on her back from the fight and some redness on the scalp area where her head was pulled and punched.

**SUSPECT TREATMENT**

DANIEL WHITE was taken to Lakeland Hospital, where he was treated for a laceration on his left cheek. R/O believes WHITE was given some liquid band aid for the opening.
