

forensic evidence points to an accidental drowning. The autopsy found no signs of injury or trauma to the body, and the medical examiner determined the cause of death to be asphyxiation by drowning. Since there is no evidence indicating federal jurisdiction and since there are no identified subjects, this matter lacks prosecutive merit and should be closed. AUSA Jeanine LaVille concurs with declination.
